When we found Sandy cowering behind some rusted rubbish bins, he was somewhat feisty and aggressive. He couldn't move most of his body much. However, he still used every bit of strength he had to make attempted snaps at our Animal Helpers.

Over time, as we nursed Sandy back to health and gave him lots of love, we noticed that he warmed up to us more. His big brown eyes that were once dark and empty grew to be full of light and joy. Eventually, Sandy even became one of the first animals to greet us in the morning.

Without Oldingham's help, Sandy would have likely died on the streets from either malnourishment or some other cause. However, thanks to the help of Oldingham and the generous support of donors like you, Sandy has now been re-homed.
