INT. TOY STORE OFFICE - NIGHT

Dilbo throws the doll inside of one of the bags. He stuffs the sewing materials and remaining 2 garbage bags inside one of his pant pockets.

INT. TOY STORE AISLE \#13 - NIGHT

INT. TOY STORE AISLE \#12 - NIGHT

INT. TOY STORE AISLE \#13 - NIGHT
Gary and the other toys all hear the approach of SQUEAKING FOOTSTEPS and a hysterical laugh. All the toys except Gary freeze in place.

As Gary attempts to start climbing down the shelf, another toy purposely puts a small cardboard box over Gary to stop him. The box has a see-through plastic screen on it.

The other toy snickers to himself then freezes again. Gary frantically hits the inside of the box that was put over him.

EXT. TOY STORE BACKLOT - NIGHT
Dilbo puts the green book in his shirt pocket again as he exits the back door of the toy store. Gary follows closely behind him. As Dilbo passes a large dumpster close to the back door, his foot gets caught on the ground.

Dilbo drops the garbage bag of toys and looks on the bottom of his shoe to discover he has stepped in some gum that was previously hidden under the snow. Dilbo starts picking the gum off of his shoe.

INT. ORPHANAGE - NIGHT CONTINUOUS
